A minimum of three years' work experience as a doctor after graduation with an MBBS degree from a recognized institution and with medical registration in Fiji.</li> <li>2. Ideally, for the post-graduate clinical programmes, one of the three years post-MBBS would have consisted of practice within the specialty area of study.</li> <li>3. Good standing with and reference from previous/current employer.</li> <li>4. A waiver to these pre-requisites can be made in certain circumstances</li> </ol>
