

Programme	Postgraduate Diploma in Internal Medicine
Programme Description	The Diploma of Internal Medicine, is the first year of a full four year MMed programme, and is largely intended to provide a base of knowledge and experience which will enable the candidate to progress to the further three years of the MMed. However, it is also considered to be a qualification which, even if not followed by the full MMed programme, will enable graduates to practice Internal Medicine at a higher level of proficiency than would otherwise be the case.

A minimum of three years' work experience as a doctor after graduation with an MBBS degree from a recognized institution and with medical registration in Fiji. 2. Ideally, for the post-graduate clinical programmes, one of the three years post-MBBS would have consisted of practice within the specialty area of study. 3. Good standing with and reference from previous/current employer. 4. A waiver to these pre-requisites can be made in certain circumstances
