It comprises medical care given to patients before arrival in hospital after activation of emergency medical services. It is an important component of the Emergency response services and its development has shown to improve response to medical emergencies in normal times as well as in disaster. This has shown to reduce mortality and improve outcomes of several medical emergencies and trauma.</p> <p>The course is designed as a short course, 10 Credit Points, which will be delivered part time any time during the year/ semester to cater for the educational needs of the EMCT's that work in the Pre-hospital environment. Offering the course part time will allow for those working to attend the course.</p>
