Programme Description	The Postgraduate Diploma in Oral Surgery programme is designed to build capacity of general dentists working in a hospital setting in the area of Oral Surgery to manage oral disease and conditions involving minor to moderate oral surgical procedures as part of the early detection and intervention approach. The training will improve the knowledge, skills, attitudes and behaviour of general dental practitioners on the principles of clinical management of patients with prescribed minor to moderate stages of common oral surgical disease conditions that are found in Fiji and other Pacific Island Countries where specialist services are not available. The programme aims to produce competent, ethical, compassionate and versatile practitioners in the art and science of Oral Surgery who can detect and manage most of the common disease conditions of the mouth, jaws and related structures that are found in Fiji and the Pacific region.
