<b>Minimum Requirements</b>	To be admitted to Post Graduate Diploma in Education, a person shall have: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. obtained a Bachelor's degree at FNU or at another recognized university normally with a GPA of 3.0 or</li> <li>b. obtained a qualification at a tertiary institution which is deemed by the FNU Senate or its delegate to be equivalent to the requirements as (a) above; or</li> <li>c. obtained a professional qualification deemed by the FNU Senate to be equivalent to the requirements set out in (a) above; or</li> <li>d. met the mature student admission criteria after an evaluation of prior learning/experience (APL) and</li> <li>e. completed a bridging research unit at level 7 for those not meeting the GPA as in (a) above</li> </ul>
